



Dee's Story (Abridged).

08.04.09 - Dee crashed sideways into a gate and smashed it, falling sideways onto a gudgeon, which tore her side through all the skin & muscle. Vet attended.

12.04.09 - Infection set in and developed big swelling along her girth and between front legs. Pale gums and shaky on her feet. Vet administered antibiotics and Dee had a penicillin reaction, but recovered quickly. Wound starting to break down alongside the stitches.

14.04.09 - TuffRock Conditioner Plus twice daily, and TuffRock Non-Medicated Poultice all over wound, changed everyday. Wound healing along nicely. Lots of gunk and dead tissue coming off. Dee very well in herself, cantering around and rolling on her wound.

21.04.09 - More pics below of wound before and after cleaning.

29.04.09 - Wound looking great and vet very impressed with healing. Melanie says... "I can't recommend this (TuffRock) enough to anyone with a wound to treat. It worked out a lot cheaper than other things I looked at such as emu oil, TAO, colloidal silver etc, and I am sure it has saved me vet visits. The only shame was I did not know about TuffRock sooner, as it would have been interesting to see if it had helped the stitches take and stopped the infection setting in. I certainly know the vet was surprised at how quickly and well it has healed and how fast the infection and swelling went down.
