

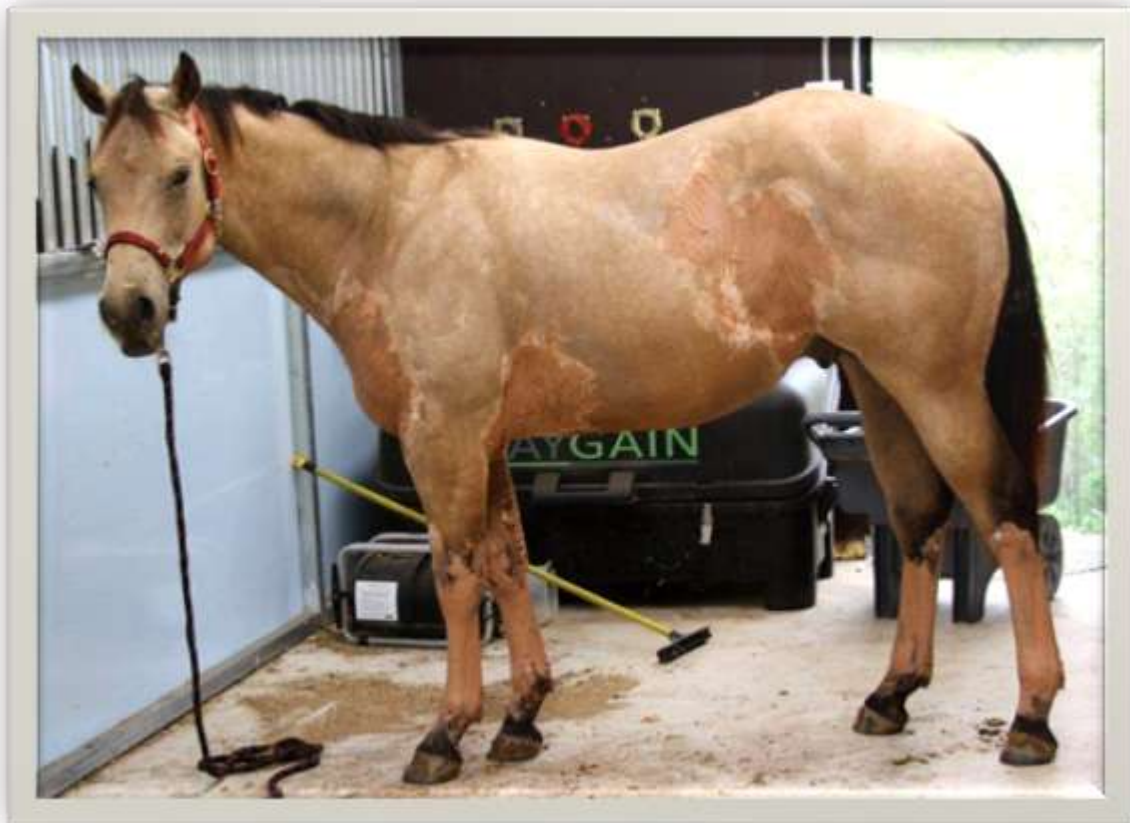
## TUFFROCK TESTIMONIAL#2
